## **Burn notification requirements:**

- Before you burn, call the burn notification line to verify that it is a burn day.
  - A burn day is:
    - Wind speed must be 10 miles per hour or less currently and for the forecasted 6 hours.
    - Humidity must be above 35%.
    - No drought conditions.
  - Location / address of the burning.
  - Name and phone number.
  - Description of the materials you will be burning.
  - The message you leave is your burn notification and is good for that day only.
- Burning is allowed during daytime hours only, no burning is allowed after dark.
- Burning is for natural yard waste only, no trash (i.e. clothes, furniture, tires, fiberglass, etc.).
- No burning any waste generated by a business, trade, construction or demolition operation.
- The burn area must be at least 50 feet from any structures and propane tanks.
- No burning is allowed against the roadway.
- There must be a 3 foot wide fire break around the entire burn area.
- Never leave the fire unattended.
- There must be an appropriate water source (garden hose) with the fire at all times.
- Flammable liquids or oils may not be used to start or maintain the fire.
- You are responsible for the fire you start. The burn notification does not relieve you of liability issues should your fire get out of control and encroach on someone else's property.

## **Restrictions:**

- The burn notification does not relieve you from following all federal and state burn regulations.
- The burn notification phone number is not to be used for burning associated with land clearing. Burning associated with land clearing will require more information and paperwork with MO DNR which will take a few days to process. These individuals will need to contact the Mid-County Fire Protection District office at 346-2049.
- Any waste generated by a business, trade, construction or demolition operation cannot be burned.
- Per state regulations, burn barrels with grates are not regulated by this policy.
