Job Opening: Training Officer / Captain

The Mid-County Fire Protection District is seeking a Training Officer to:

- Manage the Fire District's Training Division (daily shift training, volunteer training and continuing education training)
- Schedule, manage and teach the annual Firefighter I & II course
- Schedule, manage and teach the annual Emergency Medical Technician – Basic course
- Keep personnel licensures up-to-date
- Manage and develop the departments internship program
- Manage personnel training files / records
- Coordinate development of the training facility
- Serve as the Recruitment and Retention Coordinator for the district's volunteer and intern programs
- Serve as part of the incident management team
- Other duties assigned by the Fire Chief

**Mid-County Fire Protection District Benefits for Training Officer / Captain:**

1. LAGERS Retirement, MCFPD is currently at a L7 level. The district pays 10.5% of gross pay, and 4% the employee pays. For more information please see their website: <http://www.molagers.org>. Must be employed for 6 months before LAGERS is enacted.
2. MCFPD pays for Health, Short Term Disability (Off Duty) and Life Insurance (\$20,000) for employee. District will pay 50% of dependent / family health insurance.
3. Sick days are accumulated 1 every month starting after 90 days.
4. One Week Paid vacation after first year of employment.
5. MCFPD recognizes 9 holidays per year.
6. Wellness Program implemented.
7. This is an hourly (40 hour per week) position with a salary range of \$32-\$35,000 depending on experience and qualifications.
8. The work schedule for this position is generally Monday – Friday, 8 AM – 4 PM but will vary depending on training schedules. Due to some schedules trainings or events, this position will work occasional evenings and weekend.
9. This position may be called to respond to emergency calls.

**Mid-County Fire Protection District**--Formed in 1986, the Mid-County Fire Protection District located in central Missouri in the beautiful Lake of the Ozarks. This district encompasses 220 square miles in central Camden County. Our full service/multi-discipline department responds to more than 1,800 calls annually, including structural and wildland fire suppression, vehicle and technical rescue, marine firefighting and rescue, dive/water recoveries, emergency medical services, code enforcement, fire prevention/public education, along with a host of other activities and services. Our six fire stations and two fireboat docks house the following equipment: (6) engines, (6) tankers, a rescue engine, (8) brush/EMS trucks, (2) 75' ladder truck, a special operations unit, a fuel/utility truck, a dive/water rescue truck and 4 staff vehicles. The career staff consists of 6 Firefighters, 3 Captains, Administrative Assistant, Fire Inspector, Training Officer, Fire Marshal, Deputy Chief and a Fire Chief located at Station 1. In addition, the roster consists of 45 volunteer staff that responds out of all six stations. The department operates 4 divisions that include: Training, Operations, Fire Prevention and Support Services.
